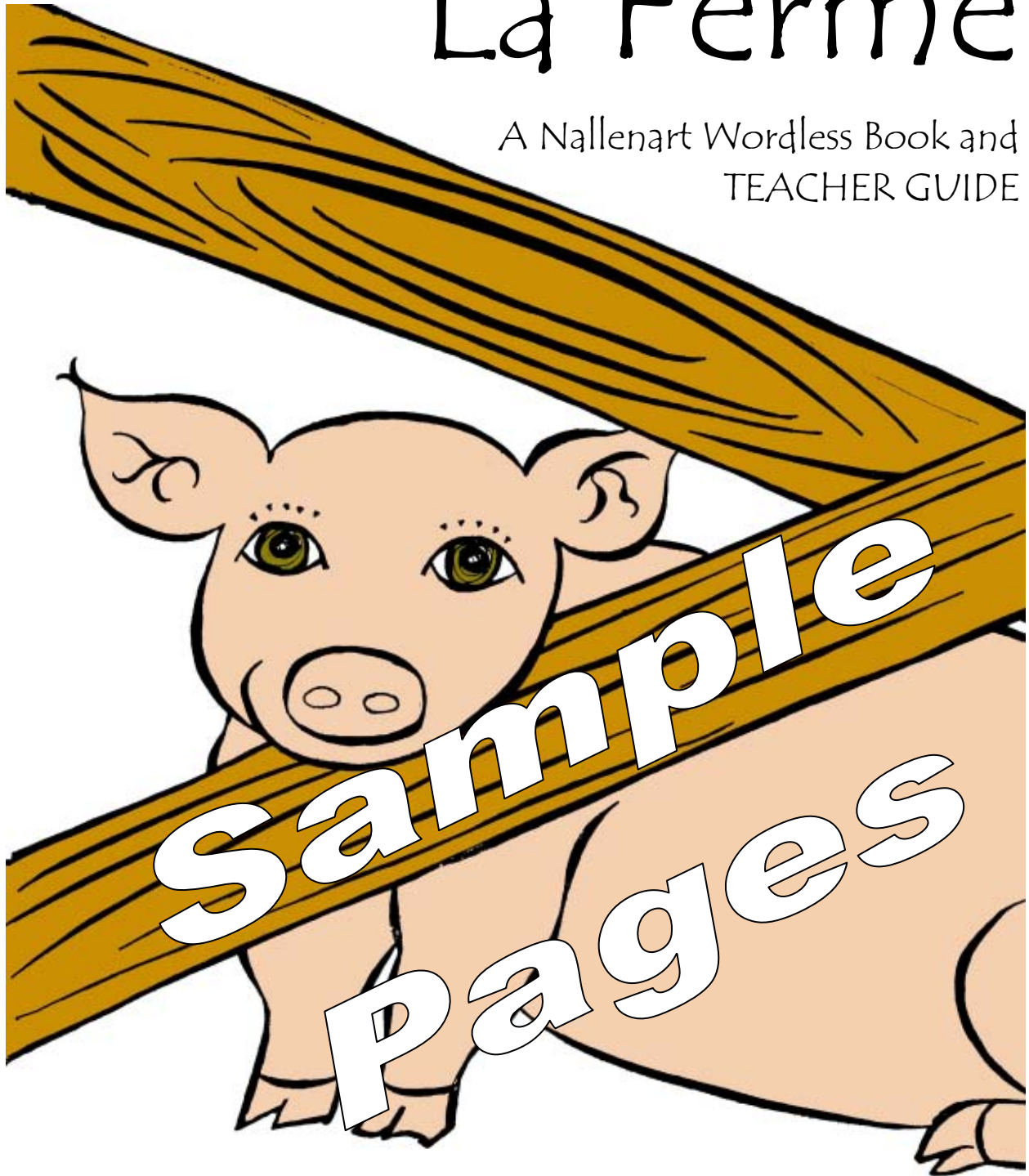

## Lesson 3 - Il y a/ There is, There are...

Teach the expressions: **il y a** = there is, or there are  
**Est-ce qu'il y a ...?** = Are there ...? Is there...?  
**des** = some, any  
**qu'est-ce que** = what...?

Use these in the context of your farm theme.

**Qu'est-ce qu'il y a à la ferme?** = What is (there) at the farm?

**Il y a deux chevaux.** = There are two horses.

**Est-ce qu'il y a des moutons à la ferme?**  
 = Are there some/ any sheep on the farm?

**Oui, il y a des moutons à la ferme.**  
 = Yes, there are (some) sheep on the farm.

When students are comfortable with **il y a**, teach the negative.

**Il n'y a pas de ....** = There aren't any ....

Ask questions to practice the negative response **il n'y a pas de ....**

**Est-ce qu'il y a des tigres à la ferme?**  
 = Are there some/ any tigers on the farm?

**Non, il n'y a pas de tigres à la ferme.**  
 = No, there aren't any tigers on the farm.

**Est-ce qu'il y a des girafes dans la cuisine?**  
 = Are there some/ any giraffes in the kitchen?

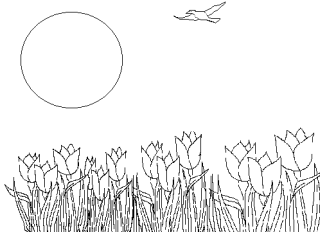
**Non, il n'y a pas de girafes dans la cuisine.**  
 = No, there aren't any giraffes in the kitchen.

## Lesson 4 - Quel temps fait-il?

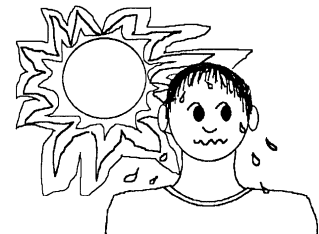
To ask what the weather is like, say **Quel temps fait-il?**

There are several ways to answer this question:

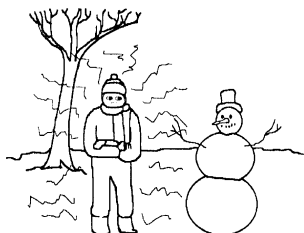
**Il fait beau.**  
 = It is nice.



**Il fait du soleil.**  
 = It is sunny.

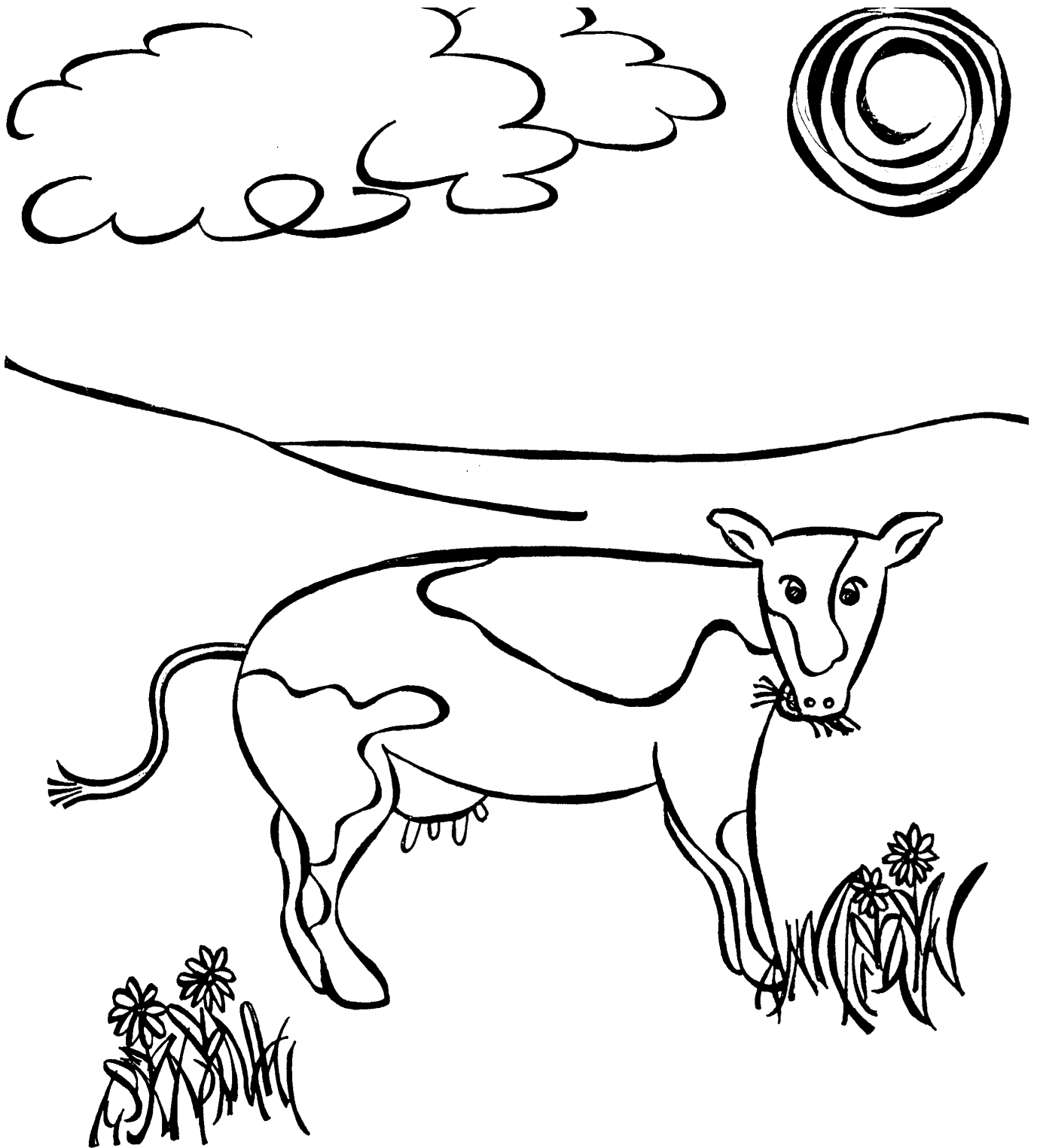


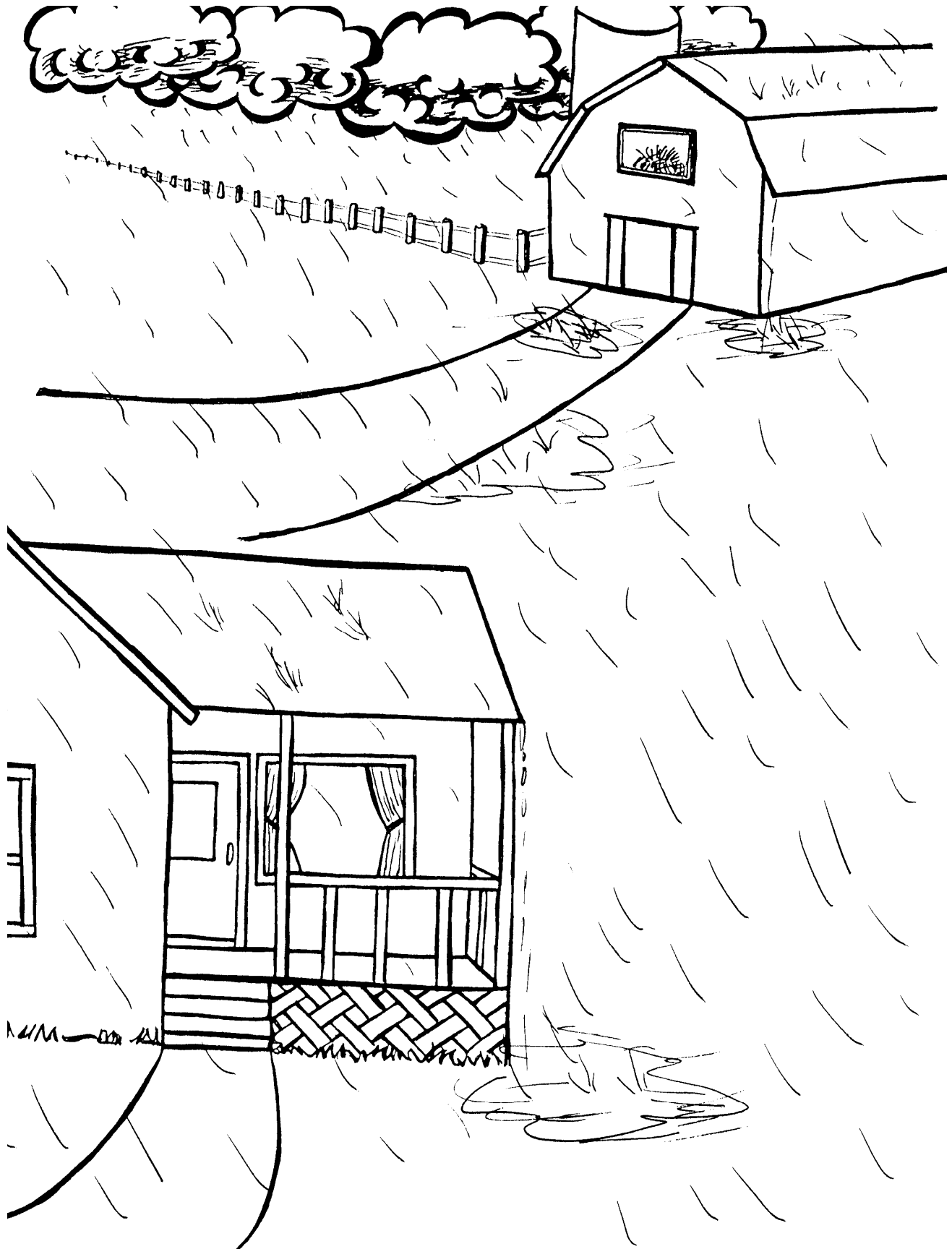
**Il fait froid.**  
 = It is cold.

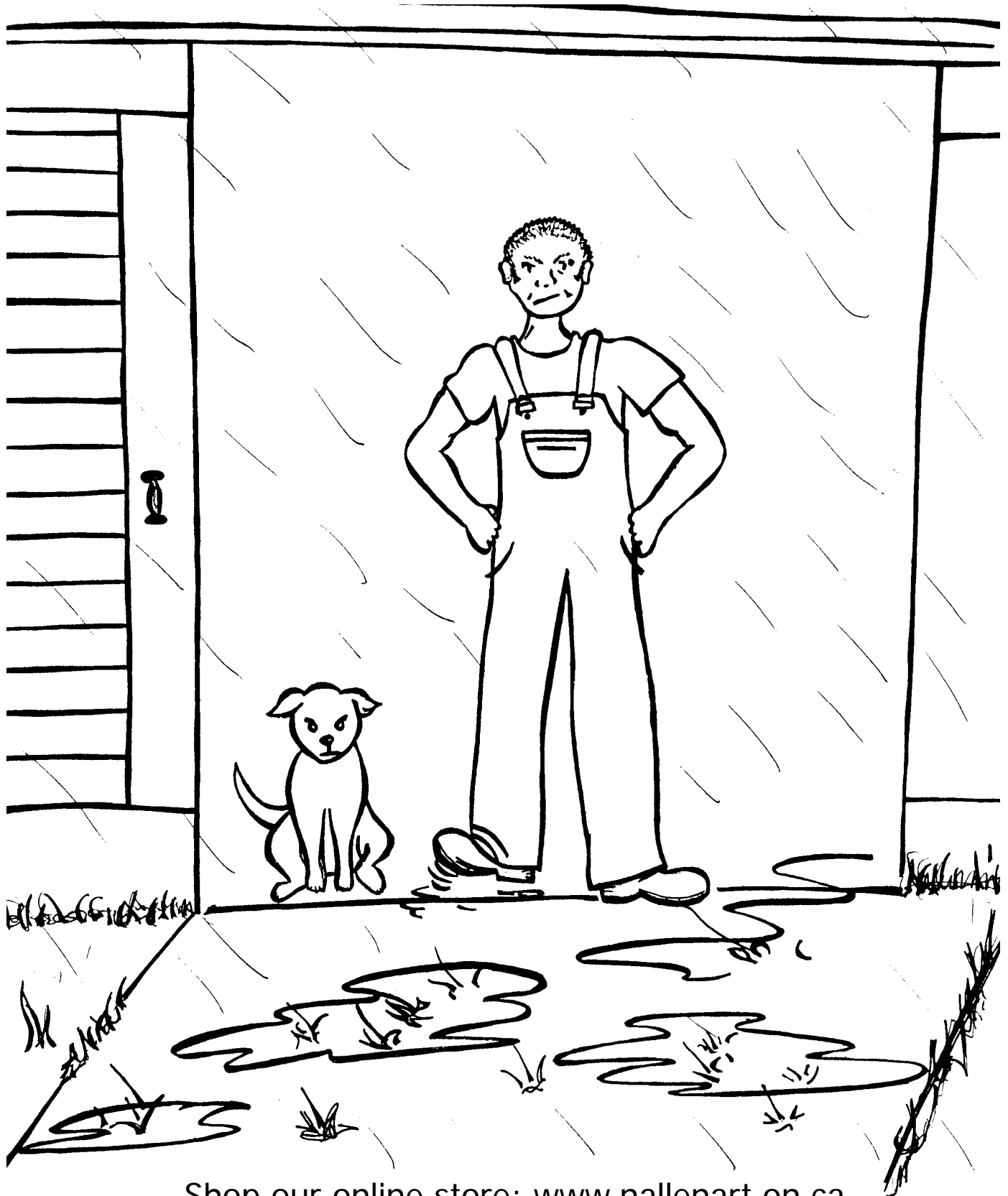


**Il pleut.**
